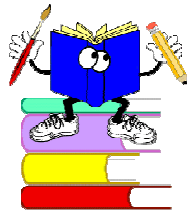


# Home Learning



## The school will :

- set interesting own work tasks and discuss these with the children.
- recognise children's efforts and achievements and celebrate these.
- provide learning opportunities through websites such as Mathletics and Bug Club.

## As a pupil I will :

- listen carefully to the explanation of "own work" activities.
- ask my teacher if I do not understand.
- plan my home learning so that it fits with other activities e.g. clubs
- Present my own learning to the best of my ability

## As a parent/carer I will :

- support and encourage my child with their home learning (see home learning flyer or school website).
- listen to my child read at least 3 times a week and record this in their diary.
- provide opportunities to practise skills in real life such as paying for items in a shop and reading a newspaper together.
- help with their "own work".

# Learning



## The school will:

- provide a stimulating environment.
- ensure children are taught at the appropriate and challenging level.
- work with children to help them improve.
- provide opportunities for children to be involved in planning work which is guided by their interests in a subject.
- keep you informed of your child's progress through reports and parents' consultations.

## As a pupil I will :

- go to bed at a sensible time so I am ready to learn.
- use the four B's if I get stuck , brain , board, buddy and boss
- reply to my teacher's comments in my book and take on board suggestions which they make.

## As a parent/carer I will :

- ensure my child has everything they need to fully participate in their learning such as , PE kit , suitable uniform and outdoor clothing.
- attend parents' consultations and discuss reports with my child.
- ask my child what they learnt at school today.
- ask my child's teacher if I am not sure how I can support my child with their education at home.

# Behaviour



## The school will :

- provide clear expectations and use rewards and sanctions fairly.

- support children's emotional and behavioural development.

## As I pupil I will :

- take responsibility for my behaviour.
- recognise and admit when my behaviour has upset others and put it right.
- speak to an adult or use the mediators if I have a problem .

## As a parent/carer I will :

- support the Geoffrey Field behaviour policy.
- speak to the school if there is any reason why my child might be finding things difficult.
- work with the school to find solutions when things are not going well.

# Attendance



## The school, will :

- keep accurate records of children's attendance and provide these on reports.
- discuss any concerns we have about your child's attendance with you.
- contact you when your child is absent unless you have contacted us.

## As a pupil I will :

- come to school each day unless I am unwell.
- arrive at school on time.

## As a parent/carer I will :

- ensure my child attends school each day unless they are unwell.
- contact the school if my child is going to be absent.
- make sure my child arrives at school on time.

# Communication , Wellbeing and Health
