

LITERACY

This half term we will be using a short film based at the seaside as an inspiration for our writing. We will be writing in a range of ways focusing on settings, characters as well as writing our own short stories using speech.



Later in the term, we will be reading a poem and using it as a model to help us write our own versions.

MATHS

We will be moving onto the year 3 addition and subtraction units. We will also be focusing on mental maths strategies and continuing to work on our times tables.

READING

Reading will be taught as a whole class this half term. We will be focusing on a different version of The Three Little Pigs. Later in the term, we will be reading a poem, focusing on the language used in the poem. For those that need it, there will still be group and individual reading. Children can continue to change their home reading books on any day.



History

This unit we will be focussing on the Stone Age. We will learn about their daily life and the legacy they left behind. The unit will end with a trip to Stonehenge.
