









<p><b><u>LITERACY</u></b></p> <p>Our literacy unit for this half term is based on the book <b><i>The Hodgeheg</i></b>. We will be reading the book together and doing a variety of activities based on it. Towards the end of the term, we will be writing our own short stories, inspired by this text.</p> 	<p><b><u>MATHS</u></b></p> <p>We will be continuing with the units on multiplication and division. Then, moving onto using this knowledge to support learning about fractions. We will continue to focus on mental maths and times tables as well.</p> 	<p><b><u>READING</u></b></p> <p>Reading lessons will take place as a whole class. We will be using the text <b><i>The Hodgeheg</i></b> and the children will be working on a variety of reading skills using this book such as retrieval, inference and vocabulary. Some children will be reading in smaller guided reading groups and/or 1:1.</p> 	<p><b><u>Science</u></b></p> <p>In our science unit, we will be learning out about the skeletons of animals and humans.
