Written statement of behaviour principles

- Every pupil understands they have the right to feel safe, valued and respected, and learn free from the disruption of others
- All pupils, staff and visitors are free from any form of discrimination
- Staff and volunteers set an excellent example to pupils at all times
- Rewards and consequences are used consistently by staff, in line with the behaviour policy
- Staff alongside pupils, work to develop and promote a set of agreed rules which cover behaviour in the class, in the playground, in assembly and around school that are understood clearly by all.
- Incidents are dealt with in a fair and consistent manner
- The exclusions policy explains that exclusions will only be used as a last resort, and outlines the processes involved in suspensions and permanent exclusions
- Pupils are helped to take responsibility for their actions and supported by the school's staff to make positive changes
- Families are involved in behaviour incidents to foster good relationships between the school and pupils' home life

The governing board also emphasises that violence or threatening behaviour will not be tolerated in any circumstances.

This written statement of behaviour principles is reviewed and approved by the full governing body every year.
