We will be learning how to write **persuasively** in our new unit based on the book "I Wanna Iguana!" We will then be reading the narrative poem Coming Home by Michael Murpurgo and comparing this to the winter poem, Something Told the Wild Geese by Rachel Field. We will use these as inspiration for our own poetry writing.

MATHS

This half term we will be focusing on addition and subtraction word problems, measure and multiplication and division methods. Will continue to have 3 x weekly times table practice and mental arithmetic.




SCIENCE

READING

It's rich vocabulary throughout and vivid characters provide lots of opportunity for discussions and for the children to work on their comprehension of inference within the text.
