The text is popular for its beautiful description and serves up a treat for fantasy story fans. We follow a young girl called Adara who befriends a majestic yet dangerous ice dragon.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Maths</u></p> <p>This term, we will begin tackling the task of mastering the KS2 arithmetic papers. We will also tackle fractions and the vast array of different methods for adding, subtracting, dividing and multiplying these tricky proportions.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Science</u></p> <p>The children will be learning about classification: how scientists group all animals and plants.
