

Beach

This term, we will be using the film 'Lucky Dip' in English and focusing on the beach in art.

- Create a picture of a seaside scene
- Write a story set at the beach
- Make a 3D sea animal
- Write an acrostic poem - BEACH
- Write a diary entry for the day you went to a beach
- Find out where the nearest beach is to us and plot on a map

Road safety

Road safety week is the 16-22nd November.

- Make a poster of road safety top tips!
- Create an outfit that will make you more visible when you are near a road.
- Carry out research to find high-visibility products (fluorescent and reflective) for young pedestrians.
- Create an idea to solve the problem of hoods, headphones, mobiles, umbrellas and other items which might stop you from seeing and hearing traffic.
- Make your own safety advert and either film one or show it through a story board.

Science

This term in science we will be finding out about rocks, soil and fossils.

- Find out facts about a well known rock formation e.g. Durdle Door or The Giant's Causeway.
- Make a drawing or poster of a rock formation.
- Make a sketch or model of a fossil.
- Find out about Mary Anning who is now well known for her fossil hunting.
- Decorate a stone or pebble.
- Do a rock survey near your home. What different things can you find made out of stone?
