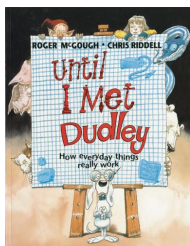


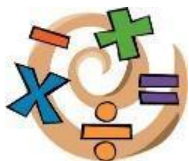
LITERACY

PSHE
