# Welcome to the Summer club newsletter!

## **SPORTS CLUBS ARE STILL FREE!**

These places will be funded using the sports premium grant provided by the government. We hope this will provide a little additional support to all at a time when cost of living expenses continue to concern us. This is not a permanent change so please make use of this while we can afford to provide it. Unfortunately, we cannot make the same offer for the non- sporting clubs due to the strict rules around this grant. We will however continue to look at ways of making the other options as affordable as possible.

All clubs at Geoffrey Field Junior School run from **3:00pm - 4:00pm**.

We are sure there will be lots of children wanting to sign up so children will be **limited to one club initially**. Should we have any unfilled spaces in any club, we will inform you and allow additional club spaces to be booked. If there is a club that you would like, and spaces have been taken, please email the office and your child will be added to a waiting list.

### **HOW TO SIGN UP TO A CLUB**

**1. Club booking opens on Monday 27th April at 6pm.**

If you have any concerns about payment, please contact the school office prior to this date to discuss. Book early as clubs do fill up quickly.

**2. Sign for up to the club that your child is interested in using Parent Mail.**

All clubs have limited space and are not offered as after school child care.

**3. Complete the Google Form to consent for your child to attend a club and to inform us of collection information.**

Please only complete the club contact form once you have successfully booked spaces on the chosen club. Click here [Summer Club consent 2026](#) to access the form.

**4. Club booking closes at the end of the school day on Wednesday 6th May.**

If a child signs up to a club, it is important they attend every session, unless unwell or there is a reasonable excuse for them to be absent.

# KIT

## **Warmer Weather**

As better weather (fingers crossed) is approaching please pack your child a drink for them to have when attending clubs. If the sport your child is participating in is an outdoor activity then ensure they bring sunscreen and a hat.

Their clothing should be suitable for the day's weather. A warm top is still advisable for those cooler days.

**Reminder that children need a PE kit to change into for all sports activities.**

## **Football, Cricket, Athletics & Tag Rugby Clubs**

These clubs will be using the field so please provide your child with suitable trainers that you are happy to get dirty. We request all footballers wear shin pads for injury prevention.

## **CLUB FAQs**

### **What happens if the club session is cancelled?**

We will try to give forewarning if a club session is cancelled; however, sometimes a club will need to be cancelled on the day. If we need to cancel a session for any other reason, we will send you a message on ParentMail as soon as reasonably possible for us to do so.

### **Do outdoor clubs run in extreme weather?**

All outdoor clubs are weather permitting; we only cancel clubs as a last resort. We do have indoor activities set aside for days where the weather is difficult.

### **Can my child swap clubs once they have signed up?**

As we only have a limited number of club spaces, we do not allow children to swap clubs once they have signed up.

### **What if the club my child wants has no more spaces?**

All clubs run on a first come, first served basis so it is advisable to have an alternative club in mind should their first choice sell out.

### **Can I sign my child up to more than one club?**

We limit all children to one club initially to give every child an opportunity to sign up. However, should we have unfilled spaces left, these will be advertised to parents and at this point children will be allowed to sign up to additional clubs.
