<p><u>LITERACY AND READING</u></p> <p>In Literacy, the children will be reading Holes by Louis Sachar. The children will be furthering their writing skills by writing for different purposes and developing control in style and formality. Grammar and punctuation skills continue to be a focus, with close attention to handwriting and presentation in readiness for secondary school. In Reading, we will be practising our school play, developing performance and fluency skills. Whilst topping up the comprehension skills following their tremendous work in the build-up to the SATS examinations</p>		<p><u>MATHS</u></p> <p>For our final term in Maths, the children will be recapping and extending all the key strands of the Maths curriculum. This means keeping up their arithmetic and reasoning skills with some revisiting of any areas of the year 6 curriculum that feature heavily in year 7.</p> <p>They will carry out practical investigations and solve real-life problems. This learning will also be extended into PSHE, where they are learning important money literacy skills.</p>	
<p><u>French</u></p> <p>The children will be learning to talk about their future plans. Learning new vocabulary related to secondary education and the new activities and subjects they will be learning.</p>	<p><u>PE</u></p> <p>The children will be progressing their skills in Gymnastics, Tennis and Athletics in readiness for Sports Day.</p>	<p><u>Enterprise</u></p> <p>In our first week back, the children will be taking part in Enterprise Week. With a World Cup fast approaching, the children will use their business acumen to promote this event and raise funds for their end-of-year party. They will receive a loan from the school to buy in products and then try to sell them as profit. The children will split into design, marketing, finance and manufacturing groups to do this. (Don't panic at home, you don't need to do anything to help with this, it is in school only.)</p>	
<p><u>PSHE</u></p> <p>The children will be learning key money management skills and extending their knowledge of how the financial system works and the importance of saving.</p>	<p><u>COMPUTING and DT</u></p> <p>Computing is linked to DT this term. We are going to explore CAD (Computer Aided Design). Children use designing and computing skills to create a marketable product. This may include opportunities for 3D printing.</p>	<p><u>MUSIC (The Production)</u></p> <p>This term, it's all about the Year 6 production. "Shakespeare Rocks".
