LITERACY

Our focus this half term will be based around the picture book, *The Paperbag Princess*. We will be revisiting the Year 2 skills to consolidate these in this unit. We will then move on to reading *Stone Age Boy* to help generate ideas linked to our topic and write recounts.

MATHS

We will be spending the first few weeks of the term revising skills taught in Year 2 before moving onto the Year 3 *Place Value* and *Number* units.



READING

Reading will be taught in small guided groups. We will be focusing on retrieval skills (finding answers in the text) and inference skills (looking for clues in the text to answer questions).

Children can change their home reading books any day.

TOPIC

Our first topic unit this half term will be *Where in the world*. We will be looking at maps and locating countries. We will then begin our Stone Age topic.



MUSIC

In music lessons, we will be focusing on Bob Marley's song *Three Little Birds*. We will be trying to identify the rhythm and pulse of the song as well as learning about reggae.
