



LITERACY



We will be writing our own persuasion pieces in literacy, exploring different topics. We will then be looking at a book by Malorie Blackman called Pig Heart Boy, which has been a huge success in previous years!



MATHS

Across this term, each class will be working on different aspects across the maths curriculum in preparation for May. The children will be doing a lot of work on arithmetic practice also.



SCIENCE

The children will be learning all about humans and animals, including the circulatory system, lifestyle choices and nutrients and water. We will be linking a lot of this into our book unit on Pig Heart Boy.



RE

To start, we will look at Christianity and the belief of things being eternal. We will then move on to looking how Christianity is still influential today, linking in to the time of Easter.



COMPUTING

To begin with, the children will be creating their own collaborative websites in computing and link this into their topic and DT project around Fairtrade. They will then get the opportunity to create their own program to meet a specification.

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MFL – FRENCH

We will learn new terminology around seasons, the environment and being in France. We will also continue to recap key vocabulary throughout.




MUSIC
